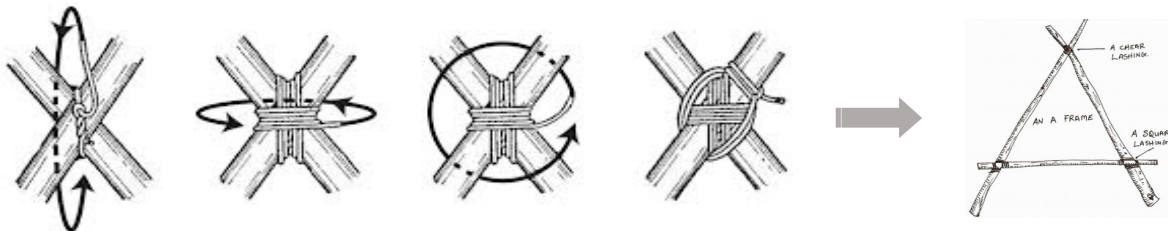


HT1 Challenge Campout April 14–April 16, 2023
